

CHRISTMAS COOKING

French Pastry-Peach Tarts.

Line small pastry tins with puff paste and half fill with orange marmalade: lay half a canned peach on each tart and a cherry on top, and bake in a quick oven. Boil the fruit syrup until it is thick, and pour a little of the syrup over the tart.

Puff paste is made as follows: Half pound of butter, half pound of flour, a half teaspoon of salt and quarter to half a cup of ice water. The secret of making god puj paste is to have all the ingredients cold.

Mix and sift the flour and salt; rub the butter into it and make as stiff as 50c. a box, 6 for \$2.50, trial size 25c. possible with ice water.

Banana Cornstarch Pudding.

Two cups milk, 1 tablespoon cornstarch, 1 egg, pinch of salt, one-third cup of sugar. Put milk in double boiler, and when hot add cornstarch mixed with a little water and stir until it is emooth. Add yolk of egg, sugar and salt mixed together. When done remove from fire, add 1 teaspoon of vanilla and white of egg beaten stiff.

When it has cooled a little, add 2 or three bannas. Do not put in bananas while hot, as it turns them black.

Doughnuts.

Cream 1 cup of sugar, with half a cup of butter or butter substitute, add two beaten eggs, 1 cup of milk, one teaspoon of nutmeg, two teaspoons of cinnamon and two cups of flour, sifted wth a teaspoon of baking powder. Work in enough more flour to make a soft dough, place on a floured board, roll out to about one inch in thickness cut into shape and fry in deep hot fat. Drain well on soft paper.
