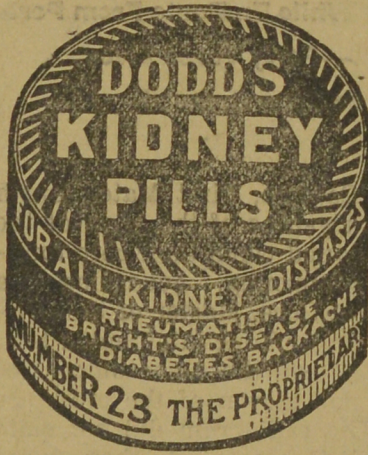
HUNS ARE NOW EXPORTING ARMS TO MEXICO

Coblentz, Dec. 18.—Two shipments of machine guns and machine gun accessories being sent to Mexico from Germany and discovered in transit, via Holland, have been held up by the allied military authorities, according to information reaching the American officials here.

The exportation of war material by Germany is a violation of the armistice and peace treaty. The German government has been asked to explain the shipment and notified not to attempt any similar exportation of such arms.

In calling the attention of the commission to the violation of the armistice terms, Marshal Foch says the bills of lading shows indications that those shipments were not "across occupied regions."

PRIVATE CAR WAS DAMAGED

(Halifax Chronicle.)

What might have been a very serious accident happened to the Railway Commission Car attached to the Ocean Limited, last evening, when a few miles west of Windsor Junction. The tire of one of the rear wheels came off allowing the opposite truck to leave the rail. This caused the breaking of a heavy iron casting which supported the car on the truck frame. Luckily the porter of the car applied the air brakes which stopped the train at a high embankment on the shore of Grand Lake.

The Railway Commissioners' car has been in use fifteen years and was in service for four years previously. It has about outlived its usefulness. As the car is of wooden construction and must necessarily travel about 15 to 20 thousand miles per year, it is very evident that other provision must be made for the accommodation of this important court if it is to continue its practice of holding sittings in all parts of Canada.

the Chairman, Hon. F. B. Carvell, Commissioners MacLean and Rutherford; Mr. Primeau, Secretary; Major Agnew, the official stenographer, and the porter, Henry Curling, to whom too much credit cannot be given for his presence of mind in stopping the train. The car was left behind and the party proceeded to the city on the train, which was not affected in any way by the accident.

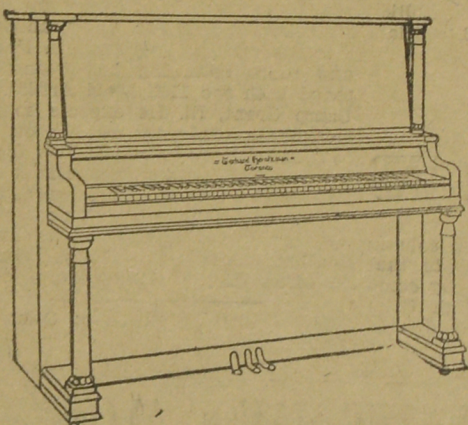

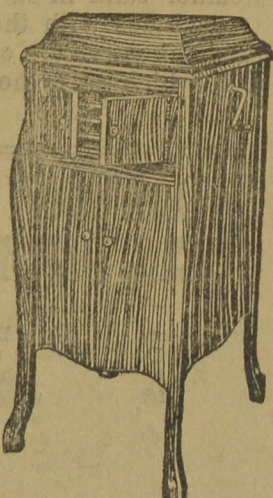
