"In Denmark and Norway the per capita savings are \$70, in Switzerland \$86, in Australia, \$91, in New Zealand \$98 and in the United States \$50.

"War Savings Stamps are designed to give every man, woman and child in Canada, the opportunity to save, and thus aid the Government in reconstructing the losses and damages caused by the war, which though ended is still being paid for and will continue to make demands upon us until all our soldiers shall have returned and a grateful country's obligations to them have been discharged.
