To preserve fresh apples, use dry sand which has been heated and cooled again. Cover bottom of stone jar 17 Corner King and Northumberland with sand, put in one layer of apples, having the fruit about one-half inch apart, cover with the sand, put in another layer of apples, and so on till the jar is full. The jar must be closed airtight and kept in a cool place. The sand will keep the apples dry and pre-
