Individual Shortcake.

Orange Custard.

Peel four sweet oranges, remove all white pith and cut in circles. Lay the slices in a glass dish and sprinkle with things for a young man if he will let it. powdered sugar. Pour over them a custard made of the yolk of two eggs, one tablespoon of sugar, one cup of milk and vanilla flavring. Put above mixture in a saucepan and set in a larger pan of boiling water. Heat slowly and stir till it begins to thicken. Do not let it boil or it will curdle. Add whites of eggs, beat thoroughly and pour over oranges. Serve cold.

Hollandaise Sauce.

With a wooden spoon cream one half cupful of butter and beat into it the yolks of two eggs, one at a time. Add one-fourth teaspoonful each of salt and pepper. Set the mixing bowl in a pan of boiling water, add one-half cupful of the boiling water and stir of one-half lemon. Should be the consistency of mayonnaise.
