The Basque Type.

One basque blouse of chic shows a shirt front peplum that forms a sort of stomacher over milady's skirt, and yet another basque ends at the waist line, but gets its line from a crushed girdle, belonging to the blouse, which holds the blouse snugly to the waist line and well over the hips. 
ABOUT EGGS.


