THE GRAMPIAN SAILED MARCH 4 FOR ST. JOHN

Ottawa, March 7.—Word has been received at the Militia Department that the troopship Grampian, with 348 Canadians on board, sailed from England on or about March 4th, and will arrive at St. John about the 12th.

Of those on board, six are for Halifax, one officer and one cadet for Charlottetown, eight officers and three of other ranks for St. John, three other ranks for Moncton, one other rank for Quebec and three cadets and 14 other ranks for Montreal.
