Another point in this connection is that the wonderful wartime efforts of Canada along these lines has shown the world that she can not only equal, but in some things excel the older and more experienced countries, so that from the standpoint of quality, Canada holds first place. With unlimited resources, animal, mineral and vegetable, with the farming country in the world, and thousands of trained workers, all the Dominion of Canada needs is a good market for her various products, and this once established, the industrial future of her citizens is assured. Already a beginning has been made; an order has been received from the British Government for \$14,000,000 worth of timber, and large orders for steel, agricultural implements, etc., are expected. This all means work for many men, for many months, which is what the Canadian Public is after.
