PULPMILL AT MARYSVILLE AGAIN BEING DISCUSSED

N. M. Jones, Manager of Nashwaak Pulp and Paper Company, to Meet Marysville Town Council Tonight—Company's Employees at Union Point, St. John County, on Strike, and Show No Tendency to Give In.

The proposition to establish a pulp mill at Marysville to manufacture the lumber cut on the limits of the Nashwaak Pulp & Paper Co., Ltd., is again to the fore. N. M. Jones of St. John, manager of the Nashwaak Pulp & Paper Co., Ltd., arrived here Monday and made arrangements to meet the Marysville town council tonight when the proposition will be talked over. Among other matters, a fixed valuation upon the plant for purposes of assessment would be required by the company.

Mr. Jones in conversation of a Mail reporter said that his company had under consideration the proposition to establish a pulp mill at Marysville to manufacture the logs from its limits on the Nashwaak river. He said the establishment of a pulp mill at Marysville would mean the doing away with the mill at Union Point, St. John County, where the logs cut on the Nashwaak now are made into pulp. Mr. Jones stated also that the decision to transfer the industry to Marysville could not be reached at once as a large number of directors and stock holders of the company would have to be consulted and their views obtained.

The limits of the Nashwaak Pulp & Paper Co., Ltd., are located on the Nashwaak and Miramichi rivers, with the exception of small areas on Little River, Sunbury County. Logs from the Miramichi limits are manufactured into lumber at Blackville. Those cut on tributaries of the St. John are made into pulp at Union Point; they have to be rafted at the mouth of the Nashwaak and towed to the pulp mill. The location of the latter at Marysville would make the long and expensive tow unnecessary. The proposal to erect a pulp mill at Marysville is not new, and for a number of years past has come up periodically. It was brought forward as long ago as the days of the late Alexander Gibson, when he owned the timber properties


St. John End of It


