Kitchener, Ont., April 19.—D. B. Detweiler, popularly known as "The Father of the Hydro," died at his home here today at the age of 60. He was instrumental in calling the first hydro meeting in this city, at which the West-

ern Ontario Hydro-Power Association was formed in 1902, which marked the beginning of the great scheme.

Mr. Detweiler was also the pioneer of the great Waterways Association for the development of the ocean traffic to the head of the great lakes.

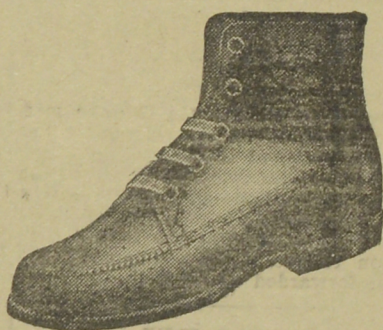

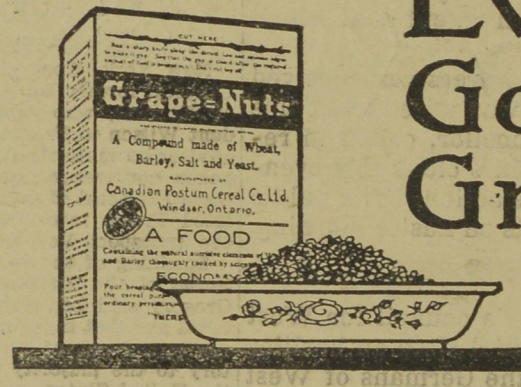
