WHEN EGGS ARE MINUS.

We Often Say We Would Rather Eat No Cake Than Eggless Cake.

Still, we feel once in a while a cray ing for cake when we really don't feel that we can afford to use more than one egg at the most. The next time you feel this craving try one of the following recipes:

One pound of seeded raisins, three tablespoonfuls butter, two teaspoonfuls cinnamon, two cups sugar, one teaspoonful allspice, one cup water, a cup of brown cofiee, one egg, three cups flour, two tablespoonfuls baking puffed-up, chafed, aching, sweaty, an they need "Tiz." powder.

Place in a large bowl the raisins, gradually one cup of water and one known. thoroughly and put it into a well buttered pan. Have ready a warm oven and bake three-quarters of an hour. A Good No-Egg Cake.

Cream one cup of sugar and butter Next add cup of milk. Mix three teal flavoring, two cups of flour. spoons of baking powder with two heaping cups of flour and a little salt. Beat light and add any flavoring. Bake in a loaf or in two Washington pie
