Strawberry and Currant. Four boxes or quarts of strawber-

berries. Place in an aluminum ware head of the circus. kettle with a little water, just enough to prevent its burning. Press the fruit a little to extract the juice from every berry. Strain the juice when it is all extracted. Return the juice to the kettle and boil 20 minutes, putting one or more sprigs of mint in it. From this point proceed as for recipe above.

Raspberry and Currant. Use equal parts of currants and rasp perries. Wash and put in preserving kettle. Simmer until all juice is extracted. Then proceed as in making strawberry and current jelly as above

CLEAN ENAMEL WARE.

When food burns to the bottom of agate or enamel ware, do not attempt o scrape it loose. With a stiff brush remove as much of the food as pos sible, then sprinkle household lye liberally over the bottom of the utensil Cover with cold water and let it come to a boil. The fire must be turned low as lye water boils over easily.

Sometimes it is necessary to repeat the operation, removing the loosened 532 Queen Street, Fredericton, N. B. particles with a long-handled brush each time.

> The utensil should be well rinsed before being placed in the dish water to avoid the corrosive effects of the lye upon the hands. A brush with stiff bristles in the end, such as used in cleaning the type of typewriters, is very convenient.

Usually every bit of the burned food can be removed in this manner without damge to the enamel.


