JELLY RECIPES.

Strawberry and Currant.

Four boxes or quarts of strawberries, 1 box or quart of currants. Crush and simmer until all juice is extracted. Strain through a jelly-bag to every pint of juice allow 3½ cups of sugar. Before adding this, put the juice on the stove and boil for twenty minutes. Heat the sugar and add to the juice. Boil until the sugar is dissolved and the jelly is clear again. Pour it into glasses which have a few scrapings of paraffin in the bottom. Set it aside to jell. When it is cold it will be sealed airtight with the paraffin which has risen to the top.

Currant Jelly With Mint.

Pick over the fruit carefully to remove any over-ripe fruit. Stem the berries. Place in an aluminum ware kettle with a little water, just enough to prevent its burning. Press the fruit a little to extract the juice from every berry. Strain the juice when it is all extracted. Return the juice to the kettle and boil 20 minutes, putting one or more sprigs of mint in it. From this point proceed as for recipe above.

Raspberry and Currant.

Use equal parts of currants and raspberries. Wash and put in preserving kettle. Simmer until all juice is extracted. Then proceed as in making strawberry and currant jelly as above.

CLEAN ENAMEL WARE.

When food burns to the bottom of agate or enamel ware, do not attempt to scrape it loose. With a stiff brush remove as much of the food as possible, then sprinkle household lye liberally over the bottom of the utensil. Cover with cold water and let it come to a boil. The fire must be turned low as lye water boils over easily.

Sometimes it is necessary to repeat the operation, removing the loosened particles with a long-handled brush each time.

The utensil should be well rinsed before being placed in the dish water to avoid the corrosive effects of the lye upon the hands. A brush with stiff bristles in the end, such as used in cleaning the type of typewriters, is very convenient.

Usually every bit of the burned food can be removed in this manner without damage to the enamel.

For the more simple costumes serge, toile de soie and tussor are preferred.

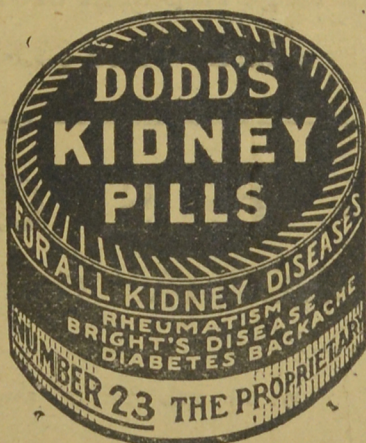
Piquette, a new twilled fabric in navy blue, is being used for early fall tailored suits.
