The commissioner of internal revenue is authorized to issue regulations governing industrial alrohol plants, to prevent illegal use of alco hol and develop the non-beverage alcohol industry.

Penalties under the dry law are varied, ranging from prison sentences to law is violated.

These include the regulation of physicians, who cannot prescribe liquor unless they are in active practice and licensed, and the physician must believe it will afford relief to the patient. Not more than one pint may be prescribed within ten days. No prescription may be filled more than once, and druggists must keep a record, similar place, etc.
