




Berry Griddle Cakes

Old Time Blueberry Pudding. To one pint of buttermilk or sour milk (if you use the latter add a tablespoonful of melted butter or two tablespoonfuls of finely chopped suet), add one teaspoonful salt and the same amount of soda dissolved in a tablespoonful of water. Beat into milk until it foams. Add enough flour to make a stiff batter and mix in one cupful of blueberries before all of the flour is used. Put in a buttered brown bread mold and steam about two hours and serve with a hot liquid sauce.

Pineapple Whip.

Beat together white of one egg, one half cup of sugar, one cup chopped pineapple (or other canned or fresh fruit) until stiff enough so bowl can be turned without mixture spilling. This can be used for frosting for large sponge cake or will serve eight per sons if used with desserts.


