

Sometimes with panne velvet, however, you use it just the reverse way-it depends on whether you want to have the material appear lighter or darker.

But, whatever you do, remember to have all the pieces cut the same way of the goods.

Different With Broacloth.

With broadcloth the rule is reversed. As you strok downward it must be smooth. With these materials there is a right and wrong and an up and down, so think twice before you start in cutting.

Now arrange every part of the pat ern on the fabric before you cut it out Don't say to yourself "I may as well get this piece cut out; it has to be cut some time and when I get it cut then I will know how much more ma terial I have on hand."


