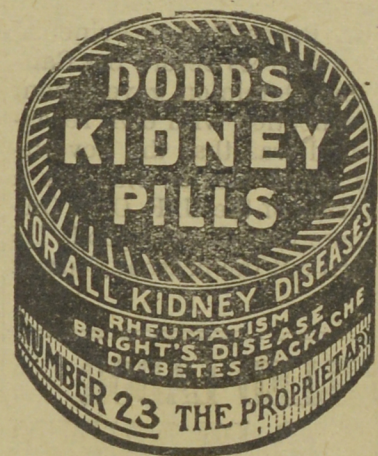

CANADIAN
EXCHANGE AT
A LOW LEVEL

Ottawa, Dec. 12.—“The only remedy is to buy less,” said Sir Henry Drayton, Minister of Finance, in commenting on the extraordinary low level to which Canadian exchange has dropped. Canadian exchange, it is further pointed out, is so related with sterling exchange that the fall in sterling may be regarded as largely responsible for the present discount on Canadian money in the United States. The question of exchange is under serious consideration here, but it is felt that any action to be really effective would have to be international.

SUGAR PRICES MAY CLIMB
DURING MONTH OF JANUARY

Large Quantities Expected to Reach New York Soon From Cuba
But Control Will Be Relaxed—The Granulated Article Expected to Relax at Sixteen Cents Per Pound—Sugar Equalization Board Will Cease to Exist.

New York, Dec. 10.—Notwithstanding twenty millions of pounds of sugar are either in New York city or en route here, with the probability of about fifty-six million pounds of the new Cuban crop arriving by the end of the month, experts in the sugar situation agree that New York is going to have to pay fifteen or sixteen cents a pound and possibly more for sugar in January.

On January 1 the Sugar Equalization Board which has kept a controlling hand on the sugar market since July 1918 will cease to exist. What will happen when the restraining influence of the Board is removed is a matter of conjecture. The Board's place said E. H. Costello, chairman of the raw sugar division of the Board, is to be taken by the law of supply and demand. The Lever act still will be in existence, but government officials fear that it will be of little value in cornering any profiteers who may seek to take advantage of the confusion that will probably exist.

At Sixteen Cents a Pound

Arthur P. Williams chairman of the Fair Price Sub-Committee on Wholesale Grocers, yesterday said that he expected granulated sugar to retail at fifteen or sixteen cents in this city next month. Mr. Costello expressed himself as being of a similar opinion.

Consumers have been inquiring whether or not the government could not prolong the life of the Board until the present crisis is past. To these queries Mr. Costello said that it is too late.

“The Board is winding up its affairs and will quit business the first of the year,” he said. “The situation is now out of hand. The barn door has been closed after the horse was stolen. This agitation should have been started last August when there was time.”

Last July the Cuban sugar producers offered to sell their entire crop for 1920 to the Equalization Board, as they had done in 1919. The matter was placed before the Washington authorities, but no action was taken, and on September 22 the Board received word from the Cuban producers that they had withdrawn their offer and were selling their crop to other agencies.

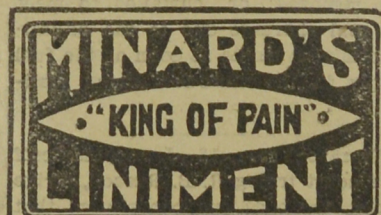
The high price will prevail notwithstanding the fact that the backbone of the sugar scarcity seems to be broken. Fifty millions of beet sugar is being shipped into the territory east of Pittsburgh and Buffalo and north of Virginia the Equalization Board announced. Twenty million pounds have been allocated to New York, part of which already has arrived and will be made available to retailers this week. Other cities are getting proportionate amounts.

The Board issued another statement denying reports that heavy shipments of sugar are being sent abroad by American refiners to satisfy foreign countries.

44,000 Tons for England

The statement says that the stocks of raw and refined sugar on hand here December 1 totalled 44,000 tons. There is due to arrive in the next few weeks an additional 28,000 tons. Of this amount, the Board asserts, 44,000 tons belongs to the British government and

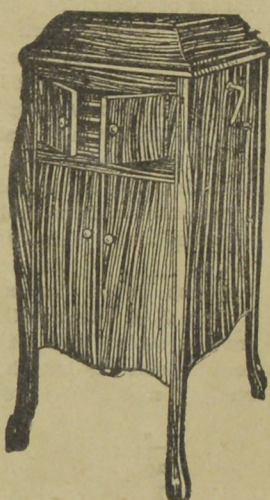
