

COLOR IN STOCKINGS.

In Paris the Fashion Has Been Set for Wearing Flesh Colored Stockings for Street Attire.

The idea is that they look as much like no stockings at all as is possible, and with the new type of French shoes the effect that is desired is undoubtedly one of bare skin.

Only a very few French women actually do go around stockingless. They have been given an amazing amount of free advertising, these stockingless Parisians, and the chances are that even they usually wear stockings.

But after all, whether or not we wear stockings, the color of these stockings is largely a matter of prejudice based upon the notions of the time we live in. For instance, there was a time about the period of the American Revolution, when the idea of a woman wearing black silk stockings was regarded as quite preposterous. Up to that time for many decades white stockings were the rule for ordinary wear and even when dressed in mourning it was considered conventional to wear white stockings.

For the opera in London a certain set of fashionable women wore scarlet stockings, but this was not half so shocking, apparently as to wear black stockings.

A few years ago there was a revived interest in brightly colored stockings, and with light frocks and white shoes you almost always choose a stocking in a color to harmonize with if it did not actually match your frock.

At some of the summer resorts there is a fad for wearing bright colored socks with white shoes and shoes of other colors too, but this fad does not extend everywhere. Perhaps the perfectly plain white silk stocking is the favorite with discriminating purchasers for wear with white shoes.

SEASONABLE RECIPES.

Cucumber Patties.

Take cold boiled potatoes and chopped celery, and dicing all, blend with a very thick cream sauce with a spoonful or two of crisp cucumber cubes. Season with celery salt and form with a little dusted flour into small oyster shapes. When they are firm, brush with butter and place in a greased shallow tin to brown and puff in the oven.

Plum Tomato Salad.

Take the little yellow plum tomatoes and cut in halves the long way. Chill till serving time. Dress on salad leaves with plain salad dressing with cubes of cream cheese dusted with paprika. The color arrangement is cooling and delightful.

Cucumbers Malabar.

Select slender, firm cucumbers, peel them, cut once the long way and remove the pulpy ends. Scoop out the centres and mix with salt, black pepper, bread crumbs and any finely cut meat, preferably chicken or pork. Add a little thickened stock and spread the top with crumbs and bits of butter. Bake for ten minutes.

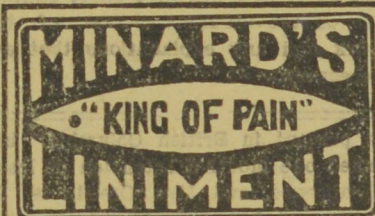
