MEMORIAL TO ALL MEN OF VILLAGE KILLED IN WAR

Tablet With Names of Sixteen Dead Heroes Unveiled Also—Impressive Services on Sunday.

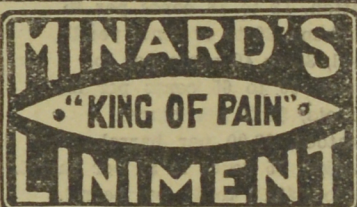
Stanley, Nov. 17.—An immense congregation assembled at the Presbyterian church yesterday to assist in the special services of dedicating the church-bell and unveiling a memorial tablet. The weather was everything that could be desired and through courtesy the other services in the village were cancelled and Rev. Mr. McCully, Methodist, and Rev. Mr. Thompson of Loggieville assisted the pastor Rev. Mr. McPherson at the morning services. As it was the intention of the young people to have the memorial bell dedicated to the memory of all the young men of the parish regardless of denomination, their wishes were met and as the congregation sat in silent meditation the bell tolled sixteen strokes for our sleeping heroes in France. It was an impressive scene.

The newly elected elders were then ordained and Rev. Mr. Thompson delivered a very helpful sermon on personal responsibility.

AN UNSUCCESSFUL SEARCH FOR CAPT KIDD'S TREASURE

Director of Spiritualist Congregation in New Jersey and Two of His Feminine Leaders, the Principals in the Undertaking—The Story of the Search Comes Out in a Court Case—Farmer Seeking to Recover on a Promissory Note.

The following relating to a lawsuit growing out of the alleged treasure buried by Captain Kidd, at Oakland, New Jersey, and deception on the part of the owner of the farm, recalls Oak Island, in Chester Basin, where thousands of dollars were sunk in search for Captain Kidd's gold. A company was formed in the sixties of this last century to recover the pirate's treasure, supposed to have been buried on Oak Island. Machinery was installed and pumps erected to carry on the work, but "never a cent was recovered." The Nova Scotian undertaking was a materialistic one, and the delusion that treasure was buried there the sole motive of the undertaking. A despatch from Paterson, New Jersey, on Wednesday last, said:

"The story of the search, with picks and shovels, on the part of a director of a 'spiritual congregation,' and two of his feminine leaders, for a \$2,000,000 chest of gold, supposed to have been buried on an Oakland, N. J., farm by Captain Kidd, the pirate, was told in Passaic County Circuit Court before George S. Setyer, in this city, today. Trial was resumed today in a suit in which Daniel Balsinger, a 75-year-old farmer of Oakland is seeking to recover \$5,000 alleged to be due from the spiritualist leaders on a promissory note, made in May, 1913. The defendants in the case are Fred Loehrs of Elizabeth, director of 'The Congregation for the Enlightenment and Teaching of the Soul and Spirit,' and Mrs. Sophie Sauter and Mrs. Marie Blumer, secretary and treasurer respectively. According to the testimony of Loehrs Balsinger told him of a vision which came to him, in which a negro girl told him that Captain Kidd had buried \$2,000,000 worth of treasure on the farm. Balsinger, Loehrs testified said that the spirit described Loehrs as the man who was to find the treasure which was to be devoted to spiritual and philanthropic work. It would be necessary, however for Loehrs to buy the farm. The congregation of the church was consulted Loehrs said, and it was agreed that the farm would be bought from Balsinger. A mortgage of \$1,300 was assumed by the congregation, and \$200 in cash paid to Balsinger. A note for \$5,000, the principal point of contention in the suit, was made payable to Balsinger, and signed by Loehrs,

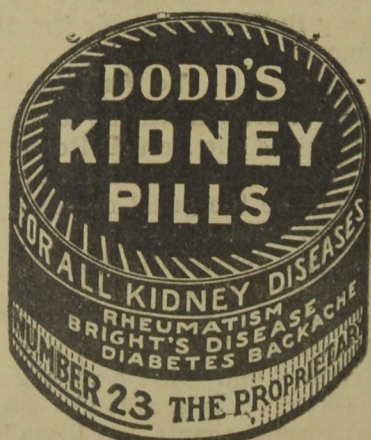

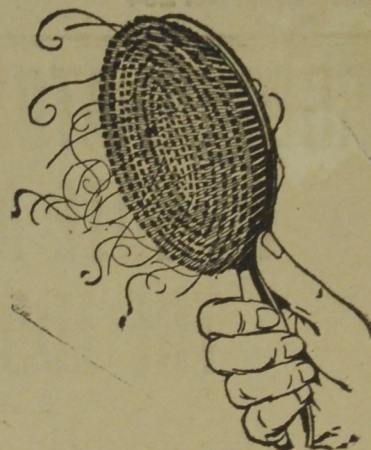

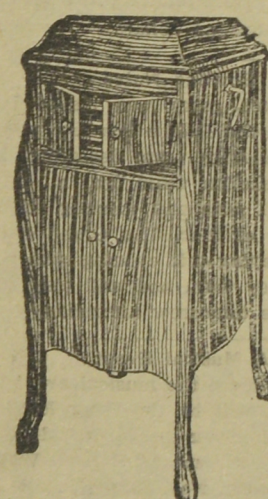
