#### SETTLEMENT BOARD WANTS GOOD FARMS FOR VETERANS AT LOW COST

Ottawa, Sept. 4.-Mr. W. J. Black, Chairman Soldier Settlement Board, announces a campaign to enlist the co-operation of municipalities and local committees in the work of locating suitable farms for returned soldiers and assisting them to setle thereon. On the need for this co-operation he said today:

In locating lands best suited to the needs of returned solders, the Soldier Settlement Board has been giving in the past every assistance of which its organization was capable.

'In some localities citizens desirous of maintaining the fine patriotic spirit which characerized this country during the war and of rendering some tangible assistance to the men settling on land who did so much for this country in France and Flanders, have formed themselves into committees to aid the Board in carrying out its programme.
