This theatre has two screens, one for showing topical reviews, short comedies and such things. It is four-

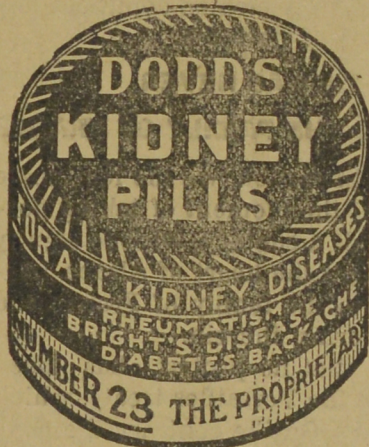
THROUGH NOON  
TRAIN, ST. JOHN  
TO HALIFAX

Nos. 13 and 14 Trains to Run  
Between St. John and Halifax—To Make Boston  
Connections.

Time Table changes effective on Canadian National Lines November 30 will affect St. John in one important particular. Trains Nos. 13 and No. 14, now running between St. John and Moncton, will run (daily except Sunday) between St. John and Halifax as through trains, and not connecting with the Ocean Limited at Moncton.

No. 14 will leave St. John at 1.40 p. m. after the arrival of the Boston train, carrying through Boston sleeper for Halifax, arriving there at 11.40 p. m. No. 13 will leave Halifax at 7.40 a. m. (except Sunday) and carry the through Boston sleeper to St. John, arriving at 5.35 p. m. This service should prove most satisfactory to the travelling public. A Standard C. N. R. Diner will run between Halifax and Moncton on these trains.

C. N. R. trains in and out of Fredericton are not affected by these train changes.

IN PROSPECT

PROVINCIAL LEAGUE  
APPARENTLY ABANDONED

J. C. Lithgow Says Farewell to  
Sport in Maritime Provinces  
—New Boxing Rules  
in London.

The Chatham Gazette says: The Chatham Hockey Club has been in communication with other clubs in the northern part of the province and all express their willingness to become members of a North Shore League. A meeting of delegates will be called next week and will very likely take place here.

(This would almost look as if the N. B. Provincial league was not regarded seriously on the North Shore.)

"Jimmie" Lethgow for years head of the Maritime Provinces Amateur Athletic Association and as such arbiter of the destinies of scores of athletes—professional, amateur and both at the same time, said good bye to sport in the Maritime Provinces last week. The occasion was the presentation of the Halifax Rugby Trophy to Dalhousie University as the winners for 1913. Mr. Lethgow is soon to leave Halifax. He made an earnest plea for straight English Rugby in the Maritime Provinces.

New boxing rules to supersede the Marquis of Queensbury Rules were drafted to London after the Carpenter-Becket bout.

The new regulations found favor, and probably will be adopted after some minor alterations as the rules of the International Boxing Federation for the control of the ring contests throughout the world.

Among rules as submitted at the London Conference is,

The proposed weight classes will include: Flyweight, 112 pounds; Ban-

teen feet high and eighteen feet wide and is 159 feet from the projection machine. The other, for showing features, is sixteen feet high and twenty-one feet wide, and is 181 feet from the booth.

The decorations are elaborate in the extreme, one individual item being 11 French rock crystal chandeliers, bought from Sherry's famous restaurant when it went out of business. The prevailing decorative scheme is of the Empire period.

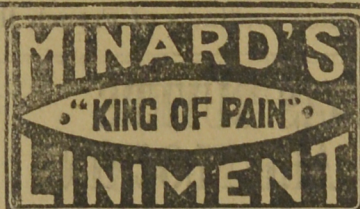

Under the new rules, all weights will be made eight hours before the men enter the ring.

Among a long series of recommendations suggested for the combined cooperation of the boxing organizations of the world is one providing that the winner of an international championship must defend his title within

one year after winning same and every six months thereafter against the best available opponent, or forfeit all right to such championship and emblematic trophy.

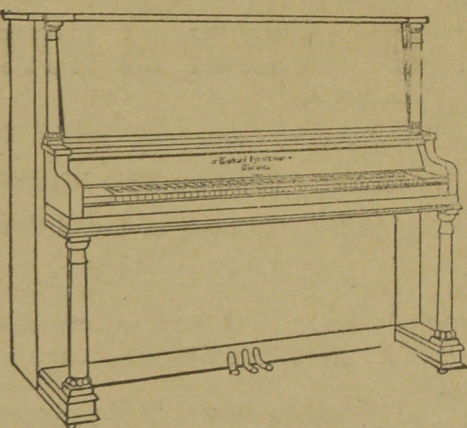
