## AN ELECTION IS NEEDED TO CLEAR THE ATMOSPHERE

Union Government at Ottawa Has Outlived Its Usefulness and  
No Longer Commands the Support of the Country—Object  
for Which It Was Formed Has Long Ago Been Achieved—  
Now on a Peace Basis.

Sir Robert Borden's retirement puts an end to the pretence that the present government at Ottawa retains office in the interests of domestic peace, and that if it were to break up and cease to govern chaos would come and the Red Cap of Revolution would be seen in the streets. The plain truth is that the Union Government has outlived its usefulness. It no longer commands the support of the majority of the Liberal electors who joined hands with Sir Robert Borden's former followers to enforce the Military Service

Act, so that sufficient reinforcements would be available to maintain the Canadian Corps at full strength. The object for which the Coalition had been formed was achieved when during the historic Hundred Days that elapsed between the opening of the Battle of Amiens in August, 1918, and the capture of Mons the sixty thousand casualties incurred by the Corps in its splendid advance were made good largely by draftees, who proved themselves to be fine fighting men and stout Canadians in the field, but would not have been available for the reinforcement of the Corps had the Military Service Act not been enforced.

Victory having been won, and the menace of German militarism removed, Liberals who had made possible the formation of the Union Government expected that the Coalition would be dissolved, and that matters of domestic policy would once more come to the front, involving the realignment of the supporters of the Government according to their former affiliations and beliefs. There were surprise and indignation when it became evident that among both ministers and members formerly known as Liberals and elected largely by Liberal votes, there existed a desire to enter into a permanent alliance with the Conservative party to cripple or destroy the historic Liberal party of Canada in so far as their action could do so. The Globe knows that in charging the ministers and members who took part in this movement with a breach of faith it voiced the opinion of many Liberal journals and electors who had supported and voted for the Union Government as a war ministry, and had never even contemplated the possibility of a permanent coalition.

tariff, the equalization of taxation, and many other domestic questions of the highest importance, shall continue to govern the country till 1923 with the support of a parliamentary majority that would be swept out of existence were the people given the opportunity of passing judgment.

The Government has changed greatly in its personnel since 1917 and when Sir Robert Borden goes, following Sir Thomas White, Conservatives will probably be as little enamored of it as the Liberals. It will be in large measure an aggregation of office holding ministers, who will be more firmly determined than ever to cling to power until the end of the parliamentary term because they know that defeat is inescapable in a general election.

It may be said that the Liberal party is no more desirous of precipitating an election at the present time than the members of the Unionist Government and that both parties are equally apprehensive of the astonishing growth and virility of the organized Farmers. That may be the view of the Liberals who regard office as the only thing worth while striving for in the political arena. It assuredly is not the view of the rank and file of the Liberal party, who believe that the question of fiscal reform should be brought to the front for immediate settlement and that in dealing with it Liberals and United Farmers members elected by the people to a new parliament would find themselves on common ground, and would be able to give their views the force of law.

In Federal affairs, as in the affairs of Ontario, we may have to face a period of group government following upon the next election, but a composite administration representing a ma-

jority of the electors is bound to prove more responsive to public opinion, as well as safer and saner, than the rump of the present war ministry, which today represents no important body of Liberal opinion, and has failed to retain the support even of the Conservatives from whom it drew its chief strength at the polls in 1917.

A general election in the spring of 1920 is the best way out of the political morass in which the people and the politicians flounder. Sir Robert Borden's successor, whoever he may be, should obtain his authority from the electors at the polls.
