CORNELIUS VANDERBILT Jr. AS A NEWSPAPER MAN

Scion of Well Known Family Anxious to Learn How the Other Half Lives—Insisted on Being a Newspaper Man When His Allowance was Cut Off—Now in the West as a Travelling Correspondent.

New York, Oct. 2—Cornelius Vanderbilt, Jr., aged twenty-two the heir to the Vanderbilt millions who accepted a job on the New York Herald as reporter a fortnight ago "to learn how the other half lives," has been compelled to go West as a travelling correspondent, for his newspaper to escape continual interruption in his work by being "trailed" by other New York reporters, male and female, seeking interviews.

Before leaving New York Mr. Vanderbilt consented to be interviewed by the Editor and Publisher, America's principal newspaper trade journal. According to the Editor and Publisher, Mr. Vanderbilt's family cut off his allowance when he insisted on becoming a newspaper reporter. The family wanted him to enter Yale University and study engineering, but the young man developed ideas about general betterment says the Editor and Publisher, and adds: "He realizes that the world is in an early stage of reformation, and he wants to do something worth while. He hates the limelight and he realizes the handicap he is under as a worker because he is a member of the Vanderbilt family."

Proof Demanded

"The stoppage of his allowance," says the Editor and Publisher, "is until he demonstrates to his family that he is better suited for the work he has decided on than for the place in the world his family would have him take. OCTOBER 9 PROCLAIMED FIRE PREVENTION DAY

Canada's Fire Loss Per Capita
is Largest in World—Fire
Prevention Day for
the Dominion.

Fire Prevention Day, which last year was observed only in Ontario, has become a Dominion wide affair and this year, October 9 has been declared as Fire Prevention Day by a proclamation of the Governor-General. The proclamation points out that the average annual loss from fire in Canada exceeds \$20,000,000 a year, that last year the loss was \$30,000,000 in addition to forest fires, and that at least seventy-five per cent of all these fires were preventable.

This year the fire prevention campaign will be educational in its tendency. There will be essay contests for school children, public meetings throughout the country, advertisements in all the newspapers calling attention to the need for a general "clean-up" of rubbish piles, etc., and in Ontario a half holiday will be observed in most centres, so that citizens can join in a general crusade against all possible causes of fire in their homes, schools, stores and factories.

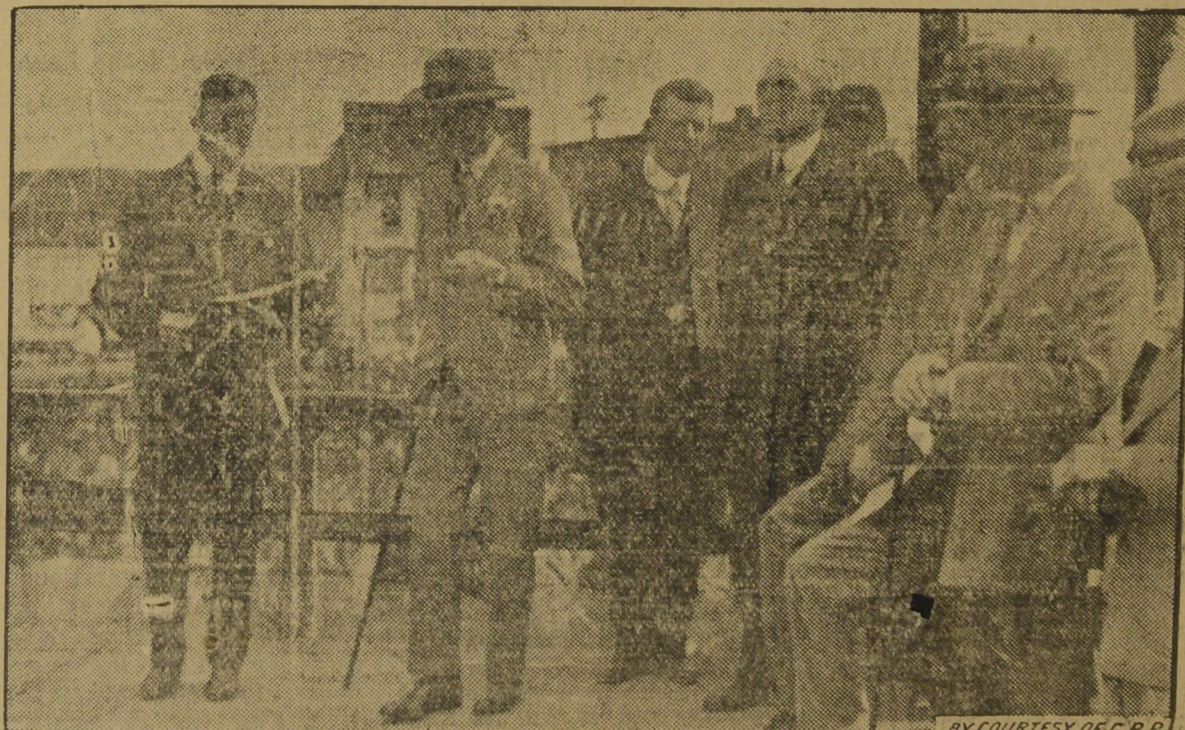
The Ontario Fire Marshal has compiled figures showing Canada's unenviable record in fire loss. The per capita loss in Canada is the greatest of any nation in the world, amounting to about \$4.00 a year. In the United States, it is \$2.73; in France, 74 cents; in England, 64 cents; in Switzerland, 13 cents, and in Holland only 11 cents.
