

## Sweet Potato Balls.

Wash and cook sweet potatoes in boiling salted water until tender. Pare and mash, add to them one well beat en egg and season with salt and pepper to taste. Beat until creamy and then shape into balls and roll lightly in flour. Fry in deep fat until golden brown.

#### Bacon and Apples.

Cook thin slices of bacon until crisp in a hot pan, then place on hot platter. Cut apples into slices without paring about quarter of an inch thick, and remove seeds.

Fry these slices of apples in hot fat from the bacon, until tender, and delicately browned. When done, drain on brown paper; then arrange on the centre of hot platter with the crisp pieces of bacon around. Serve immediately

Meat Pie With Mashed Potatoes. Two cupfuls cooked meat, 1 can to matoes drained, quarter cupful of fine bread crumbs, salt and pepper, half teaspoon onion juice, 1 teaspoonful of Worcestershire sauce, half cupful of gravy stock, mashed potatoes.

Cut meat into small pieces and arrange in alternate layers with drained tomatoes in a deep baking dish. Season each layer with salt and pepper and sprinkle with crumbs. Add onion and pour over all. Bake in the oven 20 minutes. Then remove and cover bake about 15 minutes longer, or until brown.

### FOR A SCALD.


