SECRET OF GOOD MAYONNAISE.

Depends on Having All the Ingredients of the Same Temperature Say the Experienced.

It is a good idea to use French dressing with dinner salads and to reserve the richer cooked dressing or mayonnaise for the luncheon salad, when there is a less heavy menu or when the salad forms the piece de resistance. Success in making mayonnaise the most experienced tell us, depends on having all the ingredients the same temperature, and that temperature fairly cool.

It is therefore a good idea to put all the ingredients and the mixing bowl and egg-beater in the ice box for a little while before using. Sometimes the only reason mayonnaise separates is because the beater has been freshly washed and is put into the cool mixture before it is allowed to become chilled.

If you use French dressing, an easy way to serve it is in a bottle with a close glass stopper, in which it can be shaken well. This shaking emulsifies the dressing and makes it thick and delicious with little trouble. Any glass bottle of the right size will do.

RECIPES WITH COFFEE.

Coffee Frappe.

Three cups strong coffee, one cup of sugar, one cup thick cream. Dissolve the sugar in the coffee. Chill; add the cream and freeze to a mush. Use an equal quantity of ice and salt in packing the freezer. Serve in sherbet glasses.

Coffee Sauce.

One and one-half cups milk, one-half cup finely ground coffee, one-half cup sugar, three-quarters teaspoon of arrowroot, a few grains of salt.

Scald milk with coffee and let stand for twenty minutes. Mix remaining ingredients and pour on gradually the hot infusion which has been strained. Cook five minutes and serve hot. Good to serve with vanilla ice cream.

Coffee Custard.

Four tablespoons ground coffee, one quart milk, two-thirds cup sugar, one-half tablespoon cornstarch, one-eighth teaspoon salt, four eggs.

Add the ground coffee to the milk, put in a double boiler and scald, keep the lid on during the preparation, and strain carefully. Pour the hot liquid over the well beaten eggs, sugar and cornstarch and salt. Strain and make in a moderate oven. When puffy on top and firm in the centre, the custard is finished.

Coffee jelly served ice cold with whipped cream is another delicious dessert for any time of year, and as it requires less cream than coffee ice cream or mousse, and is almost as good, many hostesses serve it oftener than the frozen dainty.

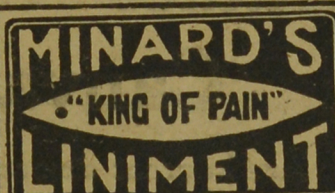

Moncton, N. B., July 15.—The building permits for Moncton city during the first half of July send the total upwards by \$68,500 in addition to about \$1,500,000 already issued. Besides those building permits, excavation was commenced today for a French Academy at a cost of \$300,000 and also for another moving picture building on St. George street. It now looks as if the total building permits will including the I.C.R. freight shed be approximately \$2,000,000 instead of \$1,000,000 first estimated.
