### FASHIONS IN BRIEF

The sash is the mode.

White suits are greatly favored at  
the beach.Hand knotted fish net makes ap-

a little frock with a very full circular

### HINTS TO HOUSEWIVES

Carrots beets or peppers improve  
the flavor of hash.Fry noodles in peanut oil and drain  
on blotting paper.If a custard curdles, beat it well un-  
til it becomes smooth.Coffee combines well with maple  
syrup and can be used for ice creams  
custards and ever so many gelatine  
desserts.When you have two or three vege-  
tables left over, even though there is  
but just a spoonful or two of each,  
combine them into a macedoine salad  
or a potato harlequin.When one or both fasteners of a  
glove have pulled out, sew tape under  
the worn places, putting an ordinary  
dress snap near the old fastening and  
the glove is useful again.

### CRUMBS OF BREAD

A few bread crumbs added to scram-  
bled eggs improve them.Bread crumbs for coating food to be  
fried is much better tasting than  
cracker crumbs.Dishes like eggplant, stuffed pep-  
pers or tomatoes, oysters and scallop-  
salmon are improved when using  
bread crumbs.Tiny cubes of bread toasted are de-  
licious to serve with either soup or  
salad.Browned bread crumbs and cream  
make an excellent breakfast food.They made delicious bread puddings  
and apple betty.They make a satisfactory substitute  
in hash when you are short of pota-  
toes.They are indispensable in meat  
loaves.To save work and scattering crumbs  
fasten a paper bag over the opening in  
the food chopper with a rubber band  
when grinding bread crumbs.

### DARN LINEN NEATLY

When darning a hole in the linen,  
do not trim away the frayed edges  
of the hole, leaving a clean outline.  
That kind of preparation only helps  
to reveal the finished darn. Cut away  
only the longest threads. Always lay  
the threads for the weaving with the  
threads of the fabric and carry these,  
and the weaving threads as well, be-  
yond the hole with small running  
stitches, so that they are anchored in  
firm material. The cloth immediately  
around a hole is sure to be weak.

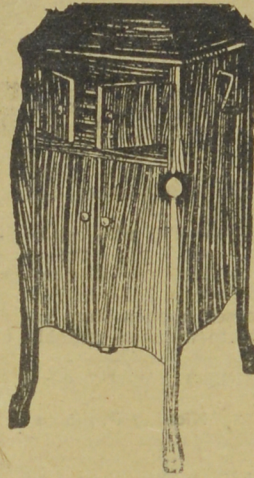

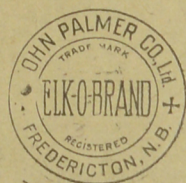
