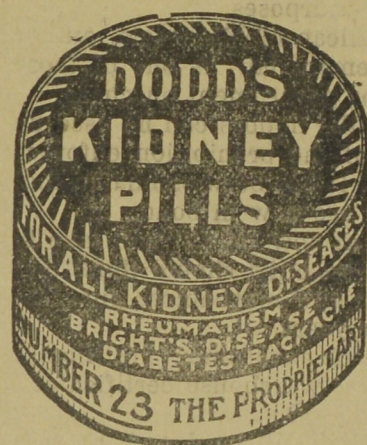

## SUSSEX HIGH BEAT GREEN HOCKEY TEAM FROM FREDERICTON HIGH 20 TO 0—VISITORS FAST AGGREGATION

Yellow and Black Has Weakest Team in its History—No Team

Work and Individuals Not Strong—Rothsley Collegiate and

Sussex High Should Play Great Game—Sussex Players are

Good in All Departments.

The Interscholastic Hockey title for New Brunswick A. D. 1920 will go to either Sussex High or Rothsley Collegiate. Fredericton High showed distinctly last night at the Arctic Rink that it had no intention of bidding for the title. The score was Sussex High 20, Fredericton High 0. The defeat was the worst ever experienced by a Fredericton High hockey aggregation and as a team the sextette could not stick-handle, skate, defend nor shoot. There is no necessity for rubbing it into the yellow and black for there were reasons for the poor showing but it is amazing that with the facilities for learning hockey which exist in this city the local high school should not have more and better material.

Absolutely Green Team

Fredericton High put on the ice a team which was absolutely green. All former players had graduated. There was evidence of sad lack of coaching in even the rudiments. With the numbers of former High School players in the city surely some one can be found to tell the boys something about the game and make them do it.

Sussex High Above Standard

Sussex High appeared to be considerably above the standard of interscholastic teams. Even allowing for the weakness of the local team the visitors had something. Rothsley Collegiate will have to travel hard and fast to get away with last night's winners.

Individual Showing

Clark the Yellow and Black captain with Cain and Kean did what little aggressive playing the locals did. Their rushes were all individual, however, with no other player up when he should have been. In addition the Sussex defence was strong.

Sussex had so little defending to do that it was hard to size the team up in that department. The last goal was scored by Keith the Sussex High point. The other nineteen were divided among Conrad, Reid and Kiley. The forwards all were fast skaters and good stick-handling. There shooting was of the best.

The visitors scored in three minutes and after that about when they pleased the Fredericton High players some times even adding in the scoring.

## NEBRASKA HEADS KENTUCKY FUTURITY LIST

Louisville, Jan. 27.—For the first time in 15 years a breeding farm other than Walnut Hall Farm or Patches Wilkes Farm, heads the list in the number of yearlings eligible to a Kentucky Futurity renewal. The top nominator for foals of 1919 is E. D. Gould's Midway Farm, Kearney, Neb., where Binges Silk, 2.07½, Gold Bingen, 2.21½, and Judge Maxey, 2.24½, hold court. The big Nebraska nursery which derives its name from the fact that it is located at the geographical centre of the United States, midway between Boston and San Francisco (on the main line of the Union Pacific) and 1733 miles equidistant from the two coast cities, qualified 47 of its 1919 foals. Walnut Hall Farm, Donerail, Ky., is second on the list with 37 eligibles.

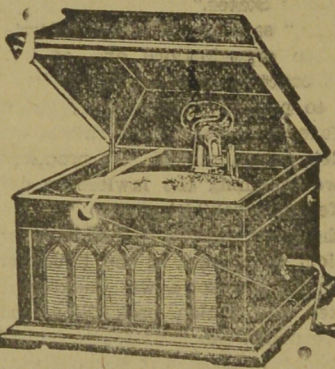
