"Married men," she explained, "get the habit of always buying in one convenient store, while the bachelors buy anywhere and everywhere. That's why all our regular customers are benedicts."

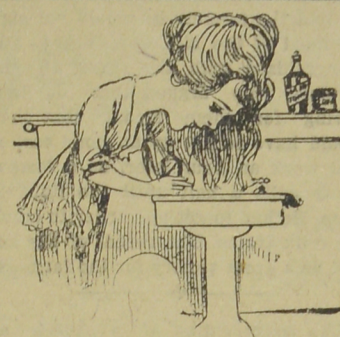

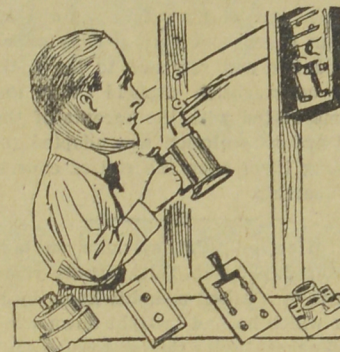

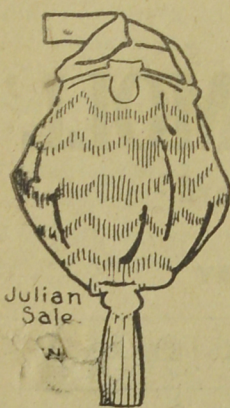
