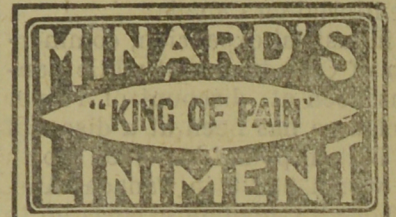

# RED SOX SELL THREE PLAYERS TO TOLEDO CLUB

Aftermath of "Babe" Ruth Sale—Boston Now Needs New Players More Urgently.

(Boston Globe)

Pitcher George Dumont, catcher Norman McNeill and outfielder Joe Wilhoit of the Boston Red Sox have been sold to the Toledo club of the American Association. In addition to the cash consideration the Boston Club is to have an option on one player next Fall.

Pres Frazee, who made the announcement at the Red Sox headquarters had no information to give out at this time as to new players to be acquired by the club, intimating that this would be forthcoming probably at the meeting of the baseball magnates in Chicago next week.

Ever since the sale of "Babe" Ruth the Boston fans have been awaiting this information, since it was said at the time that the proceeds of that sale were to be used in the purchase of other players, which by the way, was the only thing which justified the sale of Ruth, in the opinion of many fans. These still have in mind the promises made at that time.

Acquired in a Deal Dumont came to the Red Sox from Washington as a result of the three-cornered deal between Washington, New York, and Detroit last winter, in which Janvrin, Shors, Leonard, Duffy Lewis, Vitt and Chick Shorten were involved. McNeill has been on the reserve list of the club for a couple of years or more, and Wilhoit was purchased from the Wichita club last fall when he made a record for hitting safely in consecutive games. Previous to that Joe had been a member of the Boston National League club for two or three seasons.

Pres. Frazee and Manager Barrow did not think that these players meant anything in potential strength to the club and so elected not to take them to the training camp; hence their sale to Toledo.

Disposing of Wilhoit, however leaves him with only three outfielders, Hooper, Lamar and Menosky, and he will have to get another who will be a right handed hitter.

New York, Feb. 5—The estate of Thomas H. Yawkey, an owner of the Detroit American League baseball club, who died in Augusta, Ga., March 5, 1919, was appraised at \$9,427,460. His widow Mrs. Margaret A. Yawkey is the principal beneficiary. His holdings in the Detroit club were valued at \$128,138.

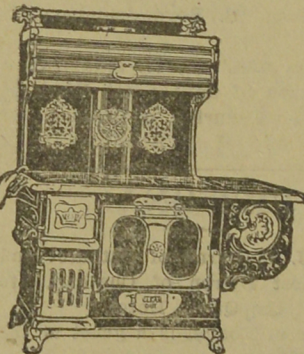

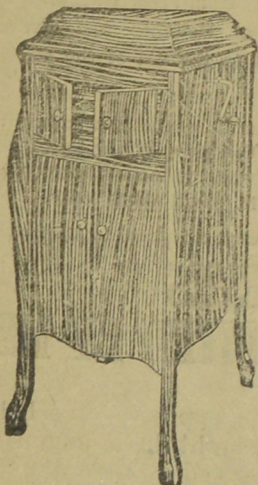
