

TRUMP CARDS PLAYED BY WIRELESS WIZARDS

Scientists Say It is Possible Now to Destroy New York from London—New Demonstrations With Radio Apparatus Indicate That All That is Necessary is a Properly Placed Mine—Apparently No Limit to Possibilities.

London, Feb. 6.—A remarkable series of wireless experiments just completed at Chelmsford has been productive of some dynamite results, not to say even more explosive discussion. That the entire manner and scale of warfare as well as the physiognomy of the battered old world can be changed as if by black magic is the claim made for the new tricks of the radio trade successfully tried out in this demonstration.

Foremost is the assertion that by this new wireless device big guns or hidden stores of explosives can be fired or exploded at long distance and the very choice example of destroying New York by pressing a button in London is brought forward by the eager protagonists of this newest feat of science.

ford test was to demonstrate a new device for giving aid to ships in distress at sea, but before the scientific reveal ended the agenda of accomplishment included such trifling topics as literal wars of the hemispheres.

The apparatus in its simpler form provides the wave length sufficient to ring bells on board every ship within the wireless radius of the vessel sending out the distress call. It is with the extension of this idea, however,

that the wireless wizards played their trump cards.

Works at 300 Miles

First they started, for argument's sake, on 300 miles, and asserted and then proved to their own satisfaction that with the proper wave length and adaptation at both ends this instrument could fire a gun or all the guns on the Pusschendale ridge by touching a lever in London.

An official of the Marconi company then declared that such an apparatus in Paris could cause an explosion in Berlin. Also it was asserted that an apparatus in an airplane could hover over an approaching enemy until his troops were over a previously hidden store of explosives and then destroy them.

Thus off to a fair start these scientists next began to pick on America. Some one asked why London could not blow up New York by this device. Some one else replied that it was very simple, with only two steps necessary. One was to increase the range of the instrument and that comparatively easy, the other was to proceed to New York and leave a "live" receiver lying about somewhere suitably hidden, and of course attached to a mine of explosives. Blew it!

It was stated that the instrument was used in experimental ways during the latter part of the war when fog guns some fifteen miles from shore were fired in the Channel by wireless rather than by a party of men despatched to the scene.

Need No Operators

However, the principal use to which the device will be put is in merchant shipping, and the experiments at Chelmsford centred about such application. It is emphasized that such an apparatus will obviate the necessity of having wireless operators aboard and will act as a sort of automatic telephone or alarm.

The more uncanny phase of the experiments was with wireless explosions. A small mine of gunpowder at Chelmsford was exploded almost simultaneously with the pressing of the button at Cambridge.

Major McCallum, an official of the Marconi system, said that the perfection of the device was foreshadowed by Marconi at the inquiry after the sinking of the Titanic. The device was finished before the war and was used on a small scale, but the Marconi company delayed its perfection until after the armistice.

MAY REDUCE THE HIGH COST OF LIVING

U. S. Reaped a Harvest

The United States of America has reaped a harvest in selling supplies to the stricken countries. According to the official reports of that country the rest of the world owed her almost \$4,000,000,000 in 1919. Practically the bulk of this was owed by Europe. She simply had to buy no matter what the price. Canada in minor fashion also benefitted by the flow of exports to Europe. But with us latterly that has been almost balanced by the exchange against us across the border.

But even the war will turn and Europe with the recent tremendous drop in exchange has had to refrain from purchasing goods on this side of the Atlantic, as with the odds so much against her it seemed impossible that she could ever pay the staggering sums that the export prices plus the premiums amount to.

Hope for Food Reductions

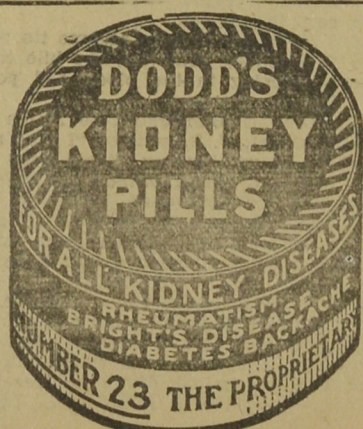
