They Were Efficient Business Men The Mesopotamians appear to have been strong on business efficiency Their letters of sunbaked clay were in serted in envelopes of the same maerial made to fit them, and their cuneiform characters were just as lucid as the modern merchant's "Sir: Replying to your favor of recent date am shipping you f. o. b.", and so forth Having deposited the letter in its en velope they used to shake in sand to fill up the spaces and save the writing from being worn off in transit.

Persons receiving letters generally threw away the envelopes which suggests awesome speculation as to the size and strength of their waste paper baskets, and the consequence is that it velope. The University of Pennsylvania Museum is intensely proud of Ex hibit 6826, which consists of an unread letter in a sealed envelope. Per haps the addressee died before it was delivered or perhaps he threw it away unopened because he divined that it was a bill.

You see, a Babylonian clay envelope was not nearly as handy as a modern paper envelope in some ways. 


