

RECIPES FOR A DAY'S COOKING.

Oatmeal Maccaroons. 2 tablespoons shortening, 3/4 cup of brown sugar, 2 eggs, 1 cup of rolled

Good Tea Cakes.

oats.

Half cup flour, 1 teaspoon baking powder, quarter teaspoon salt, half cup raisins, quarter cup nuts.

Cream sugar and shortening, add well beaten eggs, flour, oats, flour sifted with salt and baking powder, flavoring, nuts, and raisins. Drop in spoonfulls on a greased tin and bake in a

Caraway Seed Cakes.

1 cup butter or substitute, half cup of sugar, 3 eggs, flour to make dough stiff enough to roll thin, 1 teaspoonful soda dissolved in 1 cup sour milk, a quarter cup caraway seeds.

Cream the butter and sugar, add the eggs lightly beaten, flour, milk and caraway seeds. Roll thin, cut into small cakes and bake in a quick oven.

Cream Scones.

Two cups flour, quarter teaspoor salt, two tablespoons shortening, four tablespoons sugar, two eggs, half cup sour cream in which 1 teaspoon soda has been dissolved.

Sift the flour with the salt and the paking powder, cream shortening and ugar, add eggs well beaten and the of egg, sprinkle with powdered sugar and bake in a quick oven. Serve at
