HINTS TO HOUSEWIVES.

Salt in whitewash makes it stick.

Never put away a garment in need of mending.

A steel comb, such as furriers use, is good to clean the carpet sweeper brush.

Cheese adds tremendously to the relish of any tasteless substance, such as macaroni and spaghetti.

Colored rompers, or overalls give the child the utmost freedom at play and will help cut down the weekly laundry.

MARMALADE BREAD PUDDING.

Three cups milk, scalded.

Two eggs.

One quarter cup sugar.

One eighth teaspoon salt.

Six slices bread, medium-sized.

Butter.

Orange or other marmalade.

Lightly butter the bread, then spread it with marmalade, cut it in finger lengths and place it in a baking-dish. Beat the eggs and the sugar together, add the salt and milk, pour over the bread and set the baking dish in a pan of hot water. Bake until firm in the centre and serve half-warm or cold, with or without cream.

PREPARING THE SALAD.

The first secret of salad success is absolute cleanliness of the materials, says Modern Priscilla. A single faded leaf or insect ravage will spoil the entire salad. Wash the leaves in cool water, pick over most carefully and then dry, dry, dry! For if there is one most common salad sin it is to prepare a salad from leaves which are moist. This prevents the dressing from properly coating the leaves and results in wilted leaves and watery dressing. When the leaves are washed, place them in a small cheese-cloth bag and twirl swiftly in the air until the cloth has absorbed all the moisture. Lay the bag of leaves near (but not on) ice to chill and become crisp.

Nothing in the cost-reducing garden is cuter than the little beans and the way they push themselves out of the ground, back first. They cannot be denied their place in the sun.

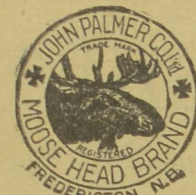

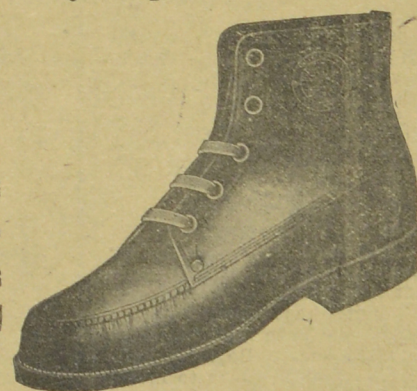
