Film Star Weds Ragtime Writer.

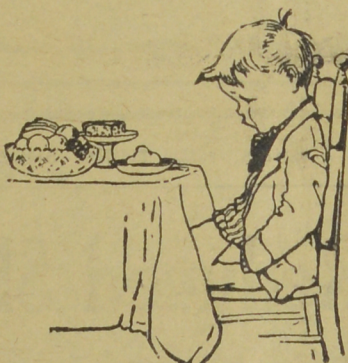
Irving Berlin, the writer of syn-
copated music is now the husband of
Constance Talmadge, one of the
younger stars on the American screen.
About six months ago, the engagement
of Mr. Berlin and Miss Talmadge was
announced, but Miss Talmadge denied
it.

Irving Berlin was born in Russia.
His father, Moses Baline, was cantor
in a synagogue. When Mr. Berlin
came to America he changed his name
from Baline to Berlin, and rapidly
rose in the music world, and is now
credited with starting the ragtime
craze in America and in Europe by
composing Alexander's Ragtime Band.
Berlin also composed "Everybody's
Doing It" and many other popular
songs. He wrote the complete score
for the musical comedy, "Watch Your
Step."

Constance Talmadge is 20 years of
age and was born in Brooklyn. She is
a sister of Norma and Natalie Tai-
madge, both film stars, but despite
her youth she is recognized as one
of the pioneer film stars. She start-
ed her screen career with the Vita-
graph company and has since starred
for Selznick and the Select Pictures
companies.

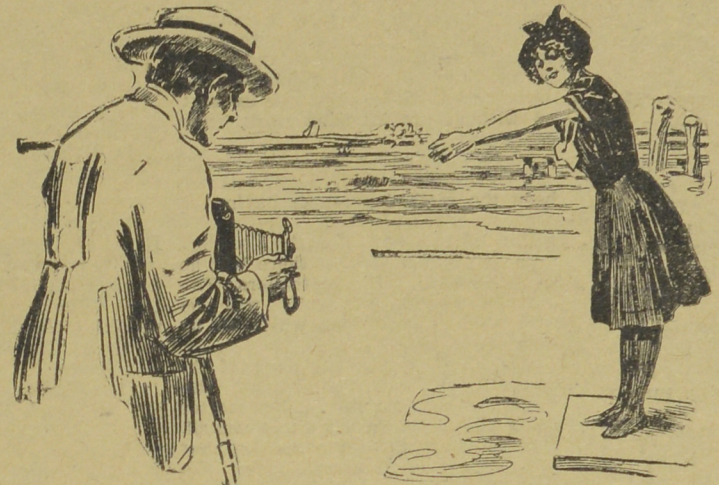

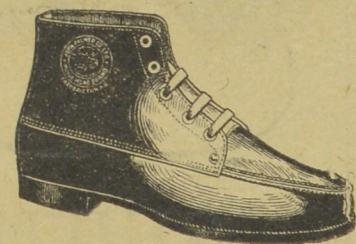

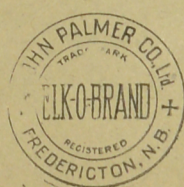
