It is to the effect that many years ago a man who had been working in another part of the province where he had obtained a considerable sum of money, was making his way to his home in Charlotte County. 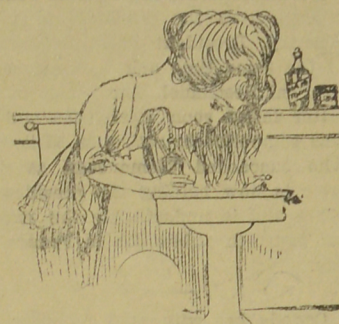
ENGLISH BURGLAR FOND OF KISSER

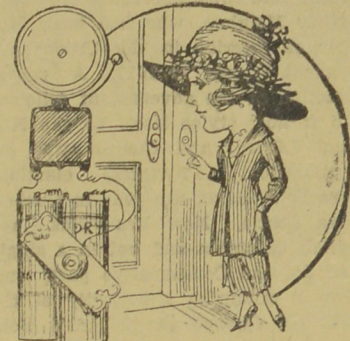
"Of course I didn't kiss him," remarked Mrs. Rowe, "but he kissed me." Shaking hands, he bade her adieu and quietly went his way.

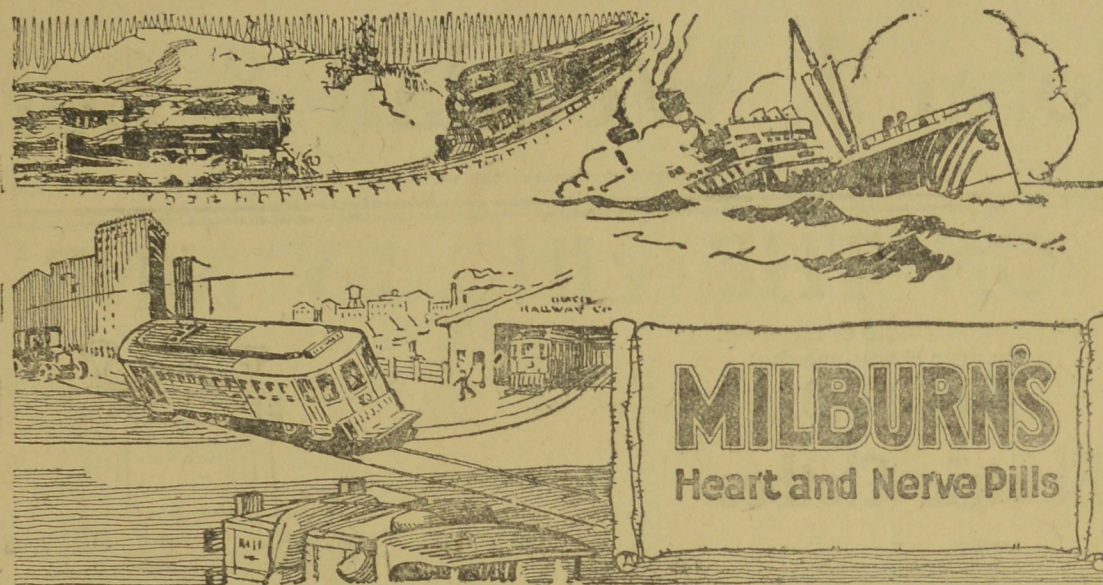
