London, Dec. 8-A startling speech on faith in miracles was delivered by Dean Inge, of St. Paul's Cathedral, known as "the Gloomy Dean," because of his pessimistic utterances on things in general at Oxford where he addressed the New Reformation Society He asked the audience to let him pro pose a personal test.

"Suppose you were offered a ride on H. G. Wells' time machine" he said. "Would you at once go and prove by ocular demonstration the two dogmas which are now so much controverted? Would you go to Bethlehem and witness the accouchement of the Virgin Mary and satisfy yourself that her physical condition was not that of lowing furs: other married women?

"Would you go to Joseph's garden very early in the morning and watch the angels rolling away the heavy stone, helping the risen Lord out of His grave clothes folding them up and laying them in a corner, handing Him the new clothes which they had brought with them-for we could not suppose that He appeared to Mary Magdalene without them-and ther watch Him issuing from the vault
