MENDING TABLE LINEN.

For mending table linen save those long even threads which have been drawn from the linen in hemstitching. Wind them on an empty spool and put aside until a tablecloth needs mending.

When the fingers of fabric gloves need mending, use the handle of the stocking darning to mend the holes in the tips. This will prevent the stitches from puckering and the mended hole will look nice and smooth when finished.

AN IRONING HELP.

Rub the iron over a branch of cedar tree leaves. It cleans the iron and gives the clothes a pleasant smell.

OILCLOTH APRON.

One of the greatest savers of soiled clothing is an apron of white oilcloth. Bind it with dark tape, as white soils so quickly. It is neat and tidy looking and when working around a gas range it reduces the likelihood of the wearer's clothes catching fire.

REMEMBER.

Should you spill hot fat on the floor or table, pour cold water on it at once. It can then be more easily scraped off before it has time to sink into the wood.

LEMON SPONGE PIE.

Line a fairly deep pieplate with crust building up the edge. Filling: 2 egg yolks beaten, 1 scant cup sugar, 1 cup milk, Juice and grated rind of 1 good-sized lemon, 2 tablespoons flour, Pinch salt. Mix well last add beaten whites of two eggs mix in lightly. Pour this into crust, bake in medium hot oven about 25 minutes until brown and firm.

HERMITS.

In response to the inquiry about hermits one of our contributors has kindly sent in the following recipe: 1½ cups brown sugar, ½ cup milk (Sweet or sour), ½ cup molasses, 1 cup raisins, 2 eggs, 1 teaspoon soda, 1 teaspoon cloves, 2 teaspoons cinnamon, Nutmeg to taste, Pinch of salt. Flour, from 3 to 3½ cups, enough to make a batter to drop from a spoon.

TO LAUNDER OLD CURTAINS.

Darn all holes by placing tissue paper underneath, then sew closely on sewing machine. Make a suds hot as can be borne on the hands. Fold the curtain flat, small enough to go through wringer. Work carefully with the hands and press through wringer. If much soiled use another suds, rinse and starch without unfolding, using wringer for each.

Spread sheets on a carpet and pin. Carefully unfold curtains, spread out perfectly true and even, then pull out each scollop; the wet curtain will adhere to the sheet without pinning and when dry will hang as true as if stretched on a frame.

Silk shirts in robin's egg blue, Nile green, dazzling orange, canary yellow, cerise, rose pink, and violet are eagerly bought. Housewives from humble homes attend sales and make purchases of from one to six of these vivid garments for father and the boys.

Meanwhile, right across the aisle there are tables full of net percale shirts which sell for \$2.50 and will doubtless outwear the silk shirts two to one. And the madras shirt, which is the one selected by the man who is revered by the sales person as a really smart dresser, sells for sums ranging from \$4 up. Men who are particular about the fit pay from \$75 to \$100 a dozen for madras shirts made to order proving that even if one is too sophisticated to spend money on silk shirts there are ways of getting rid of it while remaining in good taste.

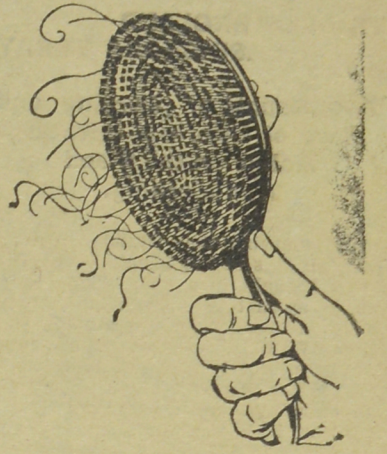
While there is nothing to be alarmed about in the silk shirt habit by itself it is one of the extravagances that men who have an eye to the future would like to see curbed.

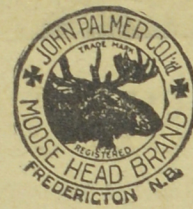

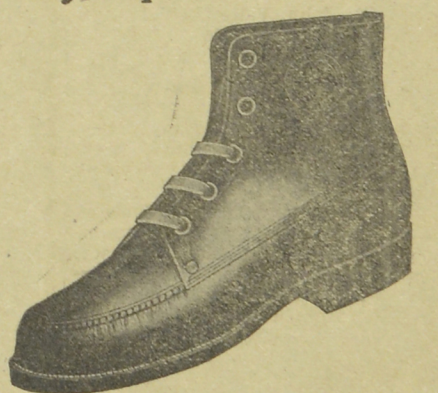
