## SWEET SPIRITS OF NITRE MAKES NEW COCKTAIL

Sweet spirits of nitre has achieved an immense popularity since the advent of prohibition, according to William S. Briry, Director of Registration, who is in charge of the drug control for the State. Although Jamaica ginger, or "Jakey" as it is affectionately called, is a sort of "lowbrow" substitute for booze, sweet spirits of nitre has a "highbrow" appeal. This is proved, Mr. Briry says by the fact that the sales have "increased to an enormous extent in the better localities of the State."

Subjected first to a process that is said to convert it into something resembling a cocktail, sweet spirits of nitre supplies the "kick" for which many seem to yearn. Consumers do not seem to know, says Mr. Briry, that they are placing themselves in danger every time they imbibe it.

As explained by the drug controller sweet spirits of nitre contains nothing but alcohol, sodium nitre and sulphuric acid. A few drops are beneficial at times in the treatment of fever, colds or kidney troubles. Sulphuric acid, Mr. Briry avers, will eat through lead.

Dean Theodore J. Bradley of the Massachusetts College of Pharmacy has this to say of the effect of sweet spirits of nitre:

"In small doses it relaxes the blood vessels, thus lowering the blood pressure, increasing the flow of perspiration and often increasing the secretion of urine. These effects are accompanied by an increase in the pulse rate and in the rapidity of breathing. In large doses the increase in rates of pulse and breathing is more marked, with giddiness, nausea, muscular debilitation and violent headaches. "In view of these facts, I believe the use of the mixture as a beverage would be harmful and dangerous."

## RECORD YEAR FOR THE FRENCH WINE INDUSTRY

With the United States, formerly one of France's biggest wine customers, pledged to "dryness" or such "wetness" as home-brewing affords, with Germany, formerly another "good spender" out of the market, and with England restricting the importation of wine by the heaviest taxation, France's wine growers are looking forward to a hard winter.
