

the islands. The Lake is studded over by a perfect archipelago, the islands numbering several thousand, some mere islets of jagged rock, others being several miles in extent on which are built pretty bungalows and camps.

Most of the islands are thickly timbered, the trees growing to the water's edge, and in the early summer months water lilies, both golden yellow and rure white are found everywhere. Blueberries and other wild fruit also grow abundantly on most of the islands, hundreds of pounds being picked by the Indians and shipped to the different cities for consumption.

Kenora itself is a pretty little town built on the lake irront, commanding a splendid view of the lake. It has a large number of stores, a Public Library, and is lit by electricity. The Tourist Hotel, in the Main Street, gives tourists every comfort.
