#### GOLD CAKE.

- 1 cup butter or substitute.
- 3 egg-volks.
- 1 egg-white. ½ cup milk
- 11/2 cups flour. 2 teaspoonfuls of baking powder.
- Pinch salt.

1 teaspoonful vanilla.

Warm the shortening, beat with the sugar until creamy, add egg-yolks, next the liquid and sifted dry ingred ients. Whole amount of beating should not be more than two minutes. Lastly add vanilla and fold in the stiffly beat en egg-white. Bake in a moderate oven for 45 minutes.


