WILL EXHIBIT MOVIES OF ANIMALS IN NATIVE WILDS

Great Preparations Being Made for the Celebration of the 250th Anniversary of the Founding of the Hudson Bay Company—Caribou, Deer, Moose and Wolves to be Depicted on the Screen—Many Scenes of Life in the Tall Timbers.

Winnipeg, Man., April 27.—No more remarkable moving photographs of wild animals in their native haunts were ever taken than those which will be exhibited free to the public during the celebration in May of the 250th anniversary of the Hudson's Bay Company in Winnipeg, Edmonton, Calgary, Vancouver and Victoria.

They were taken on two Hudson's Bay Company expeditions under Captain Tom O'Kelly and Captain Mack respectively who spent seven months in the fur country about Hudson's Bay, Athabasca and Great Slave Lakes and are intended to present to the public an epitome of the fur trade.

You catch sight of a gray spot in the woods. Suddenly it moves and stands revealed as a lynx. You see a pack of wolves dashing at mad speed across a snow-covered waste on the trail of a deer. A moose with stately antlers confronts you for a forest covert. A fox sniffs at a hidden trap. A great herd of caribou marches into the distance. You can almost hear the clashing of their horns.

You see again a wolverine held captive in a trap. The trapper musing along on his snow-shoes, stops beside his prize, unslinging his small rifle and end the beast's sufferings with a bullet through the brain. He strips off the pelt and takes it to his cabin in the white solitudes where he spends the winter alone. There he stretches it upon a frame. There are many stretched peltries decorating his lonely domicile.

Hundreds of such pictures are in

the collection, with wonderful views of old Hudson's Bay posts, fur posts and Indian villages in a wilderness of lakes, rivers and primeval forests. It is safe to say, that the street pagents with their floats and historic tableaux which will mark the commemoration of the old fur company's anniversary will not prove more interesting to the crowds than these realistic pictures of wild life in the North.

In Winnipeg, the public may view this remarkable film at afternoon and evening continuous at the Allen theatre May 3, 4, and 5. During these days this wonderful film, "The Romance of the Far Fur Country" will occupy the full time of all performances at this theatre.

Complimentary tickets are being distributed to the public generally through a special booth at the Hudson Bay Company's store and the Allan Theatre.

CARPENTIER TO JOIN CIRCUS

New York, April 26.—For \$2,000 a day, according to the circus publicity agents, Georges Carpentier, the French champion, will mingle with elephants and clowns in one of the rings of the Sells-Floto Circus. Announcement of a contract that will net the boxer \$100,000 was made today.


