## HOW TO DO A WASHING.

Just soak your clothes at night, putting the pieces in one tub, more soiled pieces into another tub. First draw the water; add some ammonia and soap powder, then put your clothes in. In the morning put boiler on, half full of water, one-quarter bar of shaved soap, one-quarter cup ammonia, one teaspoonful turpentine. Put in clothes. Let boil up, turn clothes over and let them boil up again. Take out into cold water and rub any soiled pieces. You will have to use very little soap. Put into fresh water, rinse and wring out and put into bluing water, then hang on line. This is for fine clothes.

Now for the more soiled. Rub on board to loosen dirt and put into warm water in boiler. Let boil as before, going through the same process. For colored pieces the suds water will answer.

For hose, always have a good, clean water, otherwise your hose will look dingy and that we don't want. If you do this way you will not only save labor but clothes also.

## WORTH REMEMBERING

For coffee stains on table linen, cover with borax and pour boiling water from a height on them.

Lemon juice will often relieve nausea.

A soft cloth wrung out of very hot water and applied to the face will freshen a tired face. Apply hot cloths for ten minutes, then bathe face with cold water, to which a few drops of toilet water have been added, pat dry and powder.

Strong ammonia water is good for removing iodine stains.

Alcohol is a good remedy for a shiny nose. Put a little water with the alcohol, wipe the nose over with it, then powder.

Windows can be nicely cleaned with a paste made of whiting and alcohol (wood alcohol).

To clean greasy, seal fur, heat fine sand in the oven and rub seal with it till it is free from grease. Repeat the process with fresh sand if necessary.

When the color has been destroyed by acid, apply ammonia to neutralize the acid, then saturate with chloroform, and the color will usually be restored.

Regular applications of equal parts of lemon juice and glycerine, after washing, will whiten the skin. If there is the slightest tendency to superfluous hair, never use fat or oil of any kind upon the skin.
