DELICIOUS DESSERTS.

Almond Custard.

Put two cupfuls scalded milk in a double boiler, thicken with one and one-half tablespoonfuls cornstarch blended with water, boil three minutes Add two beaten egg yolks and one half cupful maple sirup, boil a few minutes more, and two-thirds cupful teaspoonful almond extract. Chill and

Macaroon Custard.

Make a custard of two cupfuls scalded milk, two eggs silghtly beaten one-third cupful corn sirup, a pinch of salt, one-half teaspoon almond exract and one cupful crushed maca oons. Bake same as plain custard Chill and serve with or without whip-

Caramel Pudding

Stir one-third cupful brown sugar withone tablesponful butter until it turns a light brown dissolve with one pint scalded milk, thicken with one and one-half tablespoonfuls cornstarch blended with water. Boil three minute add one teaspoonful vanilla extract Serve in sherbet cups, decorate with whiped cream and chopped nuts.
