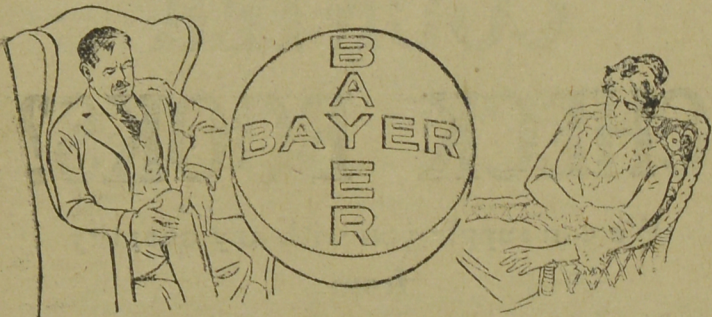

The latest report on the egg laying contest at the Dominion Experimental Farm at Nappan, N. S. shows that the New Brunswick hens are keeping up their reputation for industry. They are in competition with the hens of the other four eastern provinces, and, as last winter, are in the lead. Their latest reported average was 145.2 eggs as compared with an average of 62.8 for the other four provinces, or more than double. That is a remarkable showing.

There is evidently something in having a live farmer as minister of agriculture. Hon. Mr. Tweeddale has taken an active interest in the problem of developing the poultry industry of this province. Since he took charge the Department of Agriculture has

imported about 25,000 eggs each year for breeding purposes, and the hens which are now crowing over their rivals are the result of the efforts to secure for the province the best poultry available. Mr. Tweeddale and his department deserve congratulations. It may be too early to crow, but it looks as if the hens of the other provinces will have to work overtime to outlay the New Brunswick champions.

Interest in poultry breeding is being stimulated by these contests. New Brunswick's feathered champions, which are Banded Plymouth Rocks have apparently heeded the call to increased production. The efforts being made by the Department of Agriculture to distribute prolific breeds of poultry about the province ought to have an effect upon the cost of living.
