#### St. Valentine

A .- There are at least three differ ent Saint Valentines, all of them martyrs, mentioned in the early martyro logies under the date of February 14. One is described as a priest at Rome. another as Bishop of Interamma (the modern term). These two seem to have suffered in the second half of the third century and to have been buried on the Flaminian Way, but at different distances from the city. In William of Malmesbury's time what was known to the ancients as the Flaminian Gate of Rome, and is now the Porta del Po polo, was called the Gate of St. Valentine. The name seems to have been taken from a small church dedicated to the saint which was in the immediate neighborhood. Of the third St. Valentine who suffered in Africa with a number of companions, nothing fur ther is known.



A .- Mount Everest, the highest mountain in the world, is a peak of the Himalayas situated in the province of Nepal, in the northern part of India. Its elevation, as at present determined by trigonometrical observa tion, is 29,002 feet, but it is possible that further investigation into the value of refraction at such altitudes will result in placing the summit even higher. It is named after Sir George Everest (1790-1866), the greatest of Indian surveyors, and the founder of the Indian survey.
