SASKATCHEWAN PLEBISCITE

Regina, Sask., Feb. 28.—Indications point to the likelihood of the prohibition plebiscite being taken in this province about the last week in April or the first week in May, provided the Federal government adheres strictly to the provisions of the Canada Temperance Act and provided there is no vital amendment to the Act in this respect at the present session of the Dominion House.

The C. T. A. provides that the Federal government shall conduct a plepiscite upon the request of any province within three months from the date of the receipt of a resolution containing suc ha request from a provincial assembly. Such a resolution prepared and signed by G. A. Mantle, clerk of the Legislative Assembly, was sent to Ottawa on February 4th.
