

MAIL SORTER HAD A HAND IN RECENT TRAIN ROBBERY

Confessed Complicity in One Million Dollar Theft
Near Council Bluffs, Iowa---Two Bandits Made
Their Escape in a Motor Car---The Crime was
Planned in a Pool Room.

Chicago, Nov. 15.—Postal inspectors here announced today that Merl Phillips, a mail sorter under arrest in connection with the robbery of a treasure car attached to a mail train near Council Bluffs, Iowa, last night, had confessed a part in the crime which may have netted the robbers \$1,000,000.

The confession of Phillips describes in detail how the robbery was committed. It states that while Phillips stood on the engine as a lookout two

and waited two hours, but the men did not come, and he said he believed they double-crossed him.

The sorter is being held in Council Bluffs, where the mail car, which was on its way from Omaha to Chicago, was ransacked. The other clerks and a fourth man also are under arrest on suspicion that they may know who committed the robbery. The fourth man under arrest is held incommunicado by the Council Bluffs police. He is said to have confessed, but none of the details of the alleged confession have been made public.

Federal activity in connection with the robbery, which was one of the most daring and lucrative in the history of the railroad post offices, centred here today, as Charles H. Woods, chief clerk of Railway Mail Division No. 1, started to check up on the contents of the robbed car.

"Undoubtedly representatives of the banks in the West which shipped money to Chicago by Mail will report today on the amounts they sent," he said. "Until then we cannot say how

much the robbers got, but I believe it was more than \$10,000 and it may amount up to \$1,000,000."

The robbery was the work of only a few minutes, the police say. It was done between the Union Pacific transfer and the Burlington City depot, a distance of less than a mile. The pouches were transferred to the Burlington from the Union Pacific and the robbers gained entrance to the car immediately after it left the transfer by breaking a window. An automobile was used to carry away the loot.
