felt that the \$140 rate might appear a little too high, especially in the presence of a lower rate governing a larger output by the other group.

Wood at Highest Cost. Once more it may be in order to explain for the benefit of those who look on the business of making newsprint as exactly parallel in regard to costs with the majority of other commodities that the question of cost of manufacture is on a distinctly different basis. To quote the words of one of the leading manufacturers in Canada:

"We have two years' supply of wood made at the highest cost; sufficient coal in the yard to run the mills until next summer, which was purchased at spot market prices, and labor would not consider any reduction at this time fair." Under these conditions he believed that "the total costs for next year will be as high or higher than they were last."

It should never be forgotten in connection with the newsprint industry in both Canada and the United States that for a cosiderable period, close to lowing furs: two years, the mills were restricted in their selling price by Government control. This worked disastrously in the case of the sugar refineries in Canada, but fortunately was thrown off by legal means by the newsprint mills before very serious damage had been done. At the present time the paper mills are following out in the prices they are asking a basis of as high or higher costs of production on the one hand, and the unusual condition in any industry today of an assured demand . These two elements, cost of production and the condition of supply and demand, are governing prices generally, and in most industries are force ing heavy reductions of prices in order to liquidate stocks. The paper mills have no surplus stocks, and fortunately are able to assure themselves of prices that result in large profits.


