

Victoria Daily Times: Among the amendments to the prohibition law proposed to the government by the People's Prohibition Party, is one that prohibits any person from having in his private dwelling house a quantity of spirituous liquors exceeding two quarts, and a quantity of malted or fermented liquor exceeding two gallons. That provision, if incorporated in the act would be very difficult to enforce. A veritable army of special officers would be required, and a system of domiciliary inspection attempted.
