Mrs. Kate Waller Barrett Going to Boston—Emma Goldwyn's Niece Has a Complaint.

Mrs. Kate Waller Barrett, M. D., Sc., who is devoting her life to the cause as national president of the Florence Crittenden League of Compassion, is to be in Boston soon after the New Year, and on the 25th of January will speak at the meeting of the Greater Boston circles of the league at Hotel Tuilleries. Mrs. Barrett has a notable career in the work. In 1913 she was sent abroad as a special commissioner on immigration by the U. S. government and visited the leading capitals of Europe. During the war she was president of the National Council of Women and spent last summer in Switzerland at the International Congress of Women and has since been in Porto Rico on government work, establishing a colony for girls. The league in America last year spent \$379,000 upholding its slogan: "Every girl saved is a public asset."

Mrs. Stella Comyn Ballentine, niece of Emma Goldman, the Red who has been deported to Russia after thirty years in America preaching and practicing communism and anarchy, thinks the Ellis Island censor is no gentleman. Aunt Em wrote a letter to Mrs. Ballentine asking her to go to get her a couple of pairs of her favorite corsets. The censor concluded this was a desperate code message which might rend the republic in twain and it was struck out of the letter. Later the niece got a verbal confirmation from someone and hustled to get the special harness for aunt, who, rather more adipose tissue than the average woman totes, faced the censor overseas with dread and horror without her favorite stays.

Eleanor Fuller, aged 13, of the Harlem public school No. 77, is in line for due recognition for having a level head and possibly saving about 2,000 little schoolmates from panic at a fire which gutted the big building. The little girl saw the blaze in a cloak room and at once went up and whispered to teacher. Eleanor is a girl scout, you know and they never lose their heads. Teacher, Miss Williamson, quietly sent word to the other teachers and the principal and all dismissed their pupils regularly and calmly. The entire 1,993 got out safely, most of them not knowing the reason. Now Miss Eleanor is the heroine of the big city.


